For over sixteen years, through the seminars, she has taught the word of God in a practical, yet profound way.




At its inception, the seminar recorded a total number of one hundred and twenty people in attendance but in recent times the number has grown to thousands in a single meeting.

In 2015, the Real Woman Foundation held its seminars in March, June, September and December. The seminars were held in Nigeria, USA and UK, under the umbrella of Real Woman Foundation, Real Woman International Inc, US and Real Woman Ministries UK respectively.

REHABILITATION CENTER

EACE VILLA was established in July 2002 with the aim of positively transforming the lives of ex-commercial sex workers and ladies who have been abused. This is achieved by creating a suitable environment for them and taking them through a rehabilitation program for six months. The ladies are also counselled regularly so as to monitor their development and rehabilitation progress.

At Peace Villa, through our rehabilitation programme, we seek to address the root causes of the different circumstances the ladies have been through; rather than merely addressing their external behaviours. We also seek to help them find restoration and freedom from the effects of their past as this will positively affect their lives for good.

Since inception the Centre has rehabilitated 106 (one hundred and six) ladies. Some of them are now graduates of Covenant University, Lead City University and Ambross Alli University, while some are married. Most of them are gainfully employed. The success stories of some of these ladies

have been remarkable.

GIRLS ONLY (FGO)

he For Girls Only (FGO)
arm of the Foundation held its
workshop for girls in secondary
schools every month this year,
except in the months of April and December
Our aim is to equip girls in secondary
schools with skills and factual information
that would help them make sound decisions
and build positive relationships without
engaging in sexual activities.

The students were taught during the workshops to refrain from risky behaviours that could jeopardize their health and development. STDs/HIV/AIDS, teenage pregnancy, emotional issues were some of the problems associated with negative/risky behaviours. The workshops were also used to teach topics such as Love, Sex and Dating, Power of Choice and Personal Hygiene. They were taught how to differentiate between love and infatuation. Most of the girls were happy to be part of the workshops and promised to strive to avoid any behaviour or activity that could jeopardize their future.

A total number of 1,666 (one thousand, six hundred and sixty-six) students and 19 (nineteen) teachers were in attendance from the schools. The participating schools included: Access International School.

Life Skills Training Centre

he Life Skills training centre was set up in February 2012 with the aim of training women in vocations that could help to provide a source of income for them. It was also aimed at teaching them key biblical family values to ensure that they fulfil and enjoy the purpose of God for their families. The centre is made up of the Vocational and the Family schools.

The Vocational School covers areas like Bead & Jewellery Making, Fashion Design, Making Small chops & Non-Alcoholic Cocktail Drinks and more. The school runs for three days and many participants usually express joy for being part of the training - promising to put the acquired skills to good use.

The **Family School** started as part of our effort to equip and empower men and women with the necessary tools to find joy in carrying out God's purpose for their families. At the Family School, we offer a

wide range of courses including: Family
Finance, Communication in Marriage, God
and the family, Sex in marriage, Social vices
and more. The school runs for five days.
Training materials are given to the
participants and certificates are awarded after
the successful completion of the programme.
